## AKMS Establishment

The Arab Knowledge and Management Society was established as a non-profit institution on August 29, 1989 in Buffalo- New York in the United States. AKMS was officially registered in Amman on July 10, 1990 under the name of the "Arab Management Society".

The idea of AKMS establishment came after managers and businessmen recognized the importance of their role and its impact in serving business communities in their countries. The name of the Society was amended to become the Arab Knowledge and Management Society "AKMS" in order to emphasize its objective represented in the creation of knowledge society that utilizes modern management and technology to effectively develop Arab capabilities. AKMS is currently working through its professional representatives in 18 Arab countries.

# Minutes of Meeting for the Board of Trustees

## Amman on 9/9/2006

AKMS Board of Trustees held a meeting in Amman- Jordan on Saturday 9/9/2006 at 10 a.m. at TAGCB building- Mecca street, under the chairmanship of Mr. Talal Abu- Ghazaleh, the Chairman of the Board of Trustees. The Head of the session announced that the legal quorum is reached for the meeting of the Board of Trustees whether in person or by proxy.

**After welcoming the attendants, the members of the Board of Trustees discussed the topics listed on the meeting agenda and approved them as follows:**

- 1 The agenda of the General Assembly and the Board of Trustees meeting was approved.
- 2 The previous minutes of meeting 2005 was approved.
- 3 AKMS annual report for 2005 was discussed, and AKMS achievements were reviewed and approved.
- 4 The budget for the new fiscal year 2006 was approved.
- 5 The Chairman of the Board of Trustees paid out AKMS deficit amount of JD 23.223. The budget was approved after adding the generous donation by the Chairman.
- 6 Dr. Abdul Rahman Al- Attar donated an amount of US\$ 5000 to support AKMS.
- 7 AKMS Board of Trustees was elected and it comprised 17 members. The term of the Board membership shall be 3 years in accordance with AKMS Articles of Association.
- 8 A presentation was given about AKMS and its achievements during 2006.
- 9 The Society's qualification "ACQM" was discussed. ACQM contents are to be in consistence with the requirements of international organizations. Accordingly, those who obtain ACQM shall be considered as if they passed certain credit hours of the master program in Quality Management awarded by Talal Abu- Ghazaleh College.



- 10** Conducting a study with the International Standardized Testing Organization (ISTO) to accredit ACQM certificate.
- 11** A subcommittee was formed to study a member suggestion for holding executive training programs in management, provided that they are held on a periodic basis and on times consistent with the working hours of those who wish to participate in these programs.
- 12** Preparing ACQM brochure in consistence with the brochures of other fellow societies, and initiating the program of “How to become an Arab Certified Quality Manager”.
- 13** The Chairman of the Board of Trustees emphasized the necessity of concentrating on training programs and giving them further priority.
- 14** Conducting joint executive programs with specialized and concerned sectors dealing with the subjects of ACQM certificate.
- 15** Approving the translation of the “Certified Quality Manager Handbook” by AKMS, to become a main reference for those who wish to obtain ACQM certificate.
- 16** Discussing the possibility to place ISTO logo on training certificates in addition to the logos of Talal Abu- Ghazaleh College and the German Jordanian University.
- 17** Approving that AKMS translate certain articles from the magazine issued by the Chartered Quality Institute (CQI) in order to be included in AKMS monthly bulletin.
- 18** Inviting AKMS to attend the first meeting of Internet associations in the Arab world entitled “The Internet: a Tool to Develop the Society”. AKMS is to ask the meeting management to invite ICANN to attend the meeting.
- 19** Dr. Attar suggested that AKMS direct its efforts towards youth because they are the generation of the future. Dr. Attar invited AKMS Manager to visit the “young chamber of commerce” in Syria being an example to be followed in enhancing the role of youth in economic activities.
- 20** In conclusion, the members of the Board of Trustees thanked AKMS management for its distinguished efforts, hoping more progress for the Society.

## AKMS Activities during 2006

### Agreements and Subscriptions

AKMS was accepted as an active member by the Chartered Quality Institute (CQI) in Great Britain starting from this year. Following are some of the advantages of this membership:

- Continuously obtaining all data and publications related to quality.
- Communications are being underway to sign a memorandum of understanding between AKMS and CQI to establish a mechanism for mutual cooperation in the field of professional training and publications.

In addition, the agreement signed with ISTO has been activated. AKMS has also strengthened the collaborative relationship with ICANN. Mutual cooperation means have been reached and AKMS members have been briefed about ICANN programs and activities on a prompt basis.

Moreover, a cooperation agreement has been signed with the Saudi Management Association on 21/12/2006. The agreement will provide an opportunity for cooperation in many fields such as training and holding scientific meetings, conferences, seminars, group discussions and workshops.

### The Arab Certified Quality Manager Program (ACQM)

During 2006, AKMS exerted great efforts and realized major achievements. One of these achievements and changes is to use Arabic name of the certificate to correspond to the English name "Arab Certified Quality Manager".

AKMS has also sought the accreditation of ACQM certificate by many parties, including the British Chartered Quality Institute (CQI), and followed up obtaining a license to translate ISO Management Magazine into Arabic.

AKMS endeavored in cooperation with the American Society for Quality (ASQ) to translate the Certified Quality Manager Handbook to be a reference for those applying to the ACQM certificate, after developing a special structure for ACQM examination that is consistent with the international requirements of this certificate.

AKMS prepared special marketing tools and commenced promoting the Arab Certified Quality Manager Certificate at the local and Arab levels. It also established a new advisory board for ACQM examinations.

ACQM Board met twice on 16/11/2006 and 23/11/2006. Discussions were made with Mr. Osama Hammad, the Chairman of Jordan Society Quality, to sign a cooperation agreement that focus on several aspects, the most notably is the ACQM certificate and the means through which both parties can be engaged in preparing and initiating this qualification.



## AKMS Membership

Membership fees were amended to become US\$ 100 for individuals and US\$ 200 for institutions. The amendment decision was taken after conducting a study of membership fees approved in institutions operating in the same field in order to meet the financial burdens and obligations resulting from training and qualification programs. AKMS membership fee is considered low compared to other membership fees for institutions operating in the same field.

In addition, members are given 50% discount to the training courses held by AKMS. Coordination has also been made between AKMS and Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Professional Training to grant members 10% discount to the courses held by Talal Abu- Ghazaleh Professional Training in the Arab Countries. Moreover, AKMS provided its representatives in the Arab countries with the membership brochure to be circulated to members and enhance communication with them in order to promote ACQM qualification.

## Marketing Activities

With respect to AKMS marketing and relevant activities, coordination was made with the Chairman of the National Society for Investor Protection/ Jordan Engineers Association to prepare a working paper entitled "Knowledge Management Framework and Technologies" representing AKMS. This paper was prepared and presented by Mr. Fadi Abdul Hamid (AKMS members). In addition, a media plan for AKMS was prepared for marketing the programs until the end of 2006 with financial provisions of JD 5233. A presentation was also prepared in both Arabic and English languages to introduce AKMS, its objectives and activities in future meetings and occasions.

AKMS participated in many exhibitions, most notably the International Exhibition for Education and Training held under the patronage of the Minister of Education and the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research in cooperation with the Jordanian Ministry of Culture in Zara Hall- Grand Hyatt Amman during the period 17-19 May 2006.

Further, AKMS participated in the Real Estate & Investment Exhibition 2006- Jordan held during the period 6-10 Nov. 2006 and included major companies of construction and real estate in Jordan and the Arab world, where each company displayed and introduced its projects. In addition, AKMS participated during the period 7-9 Nov. 2006 in the 10th Jordanian Exhibition for Education (JETE 2006), in which ACQM certificate was introduced. AKMS benefited from this exhibition through the distribution of brochures introducing AKMS present and future activities and programs.

AKMS has also developed a database of companies in the Arab countries (Kuwait, Oman, Yemen, Egypt, Jordan, Bahrain, Qatar, United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia) which it used in promoting its services and activities.

## Training Courses

Cooperation has been made with specialized companies to market the training courses on broader base such as Click Jordan. It has also been agreed with the regional training office to the mechanism of cooperation with AKMS for conducting training courses. In addition, a database of experts has been established in the field of training including more than 250 Cvs.

AKMS held a set of training courses at Talal Abu- Ghazaleh College of Business- the German Jordanian University as follows:

- "Essentials of Total Quality Managements and ISO Series 9000" during the period 15-17 May 2006.
- "Project management" during the period 24-28 June 2006.
- "Excellence in Customer Service" during the period 21-23 Aug. 2005.
- "Business Networks and Time Management" during the period 21-23 Nov. 2006.

Due to the increasing number of training courses held, AKMS has been provided with a specialized registration system for the training courses. This system facilitates the process of data registration and maintenance of these courses. This system is also significant in analyzing and evaluating the final results of training courses, focusing thereby on promoting the quality of these courses.

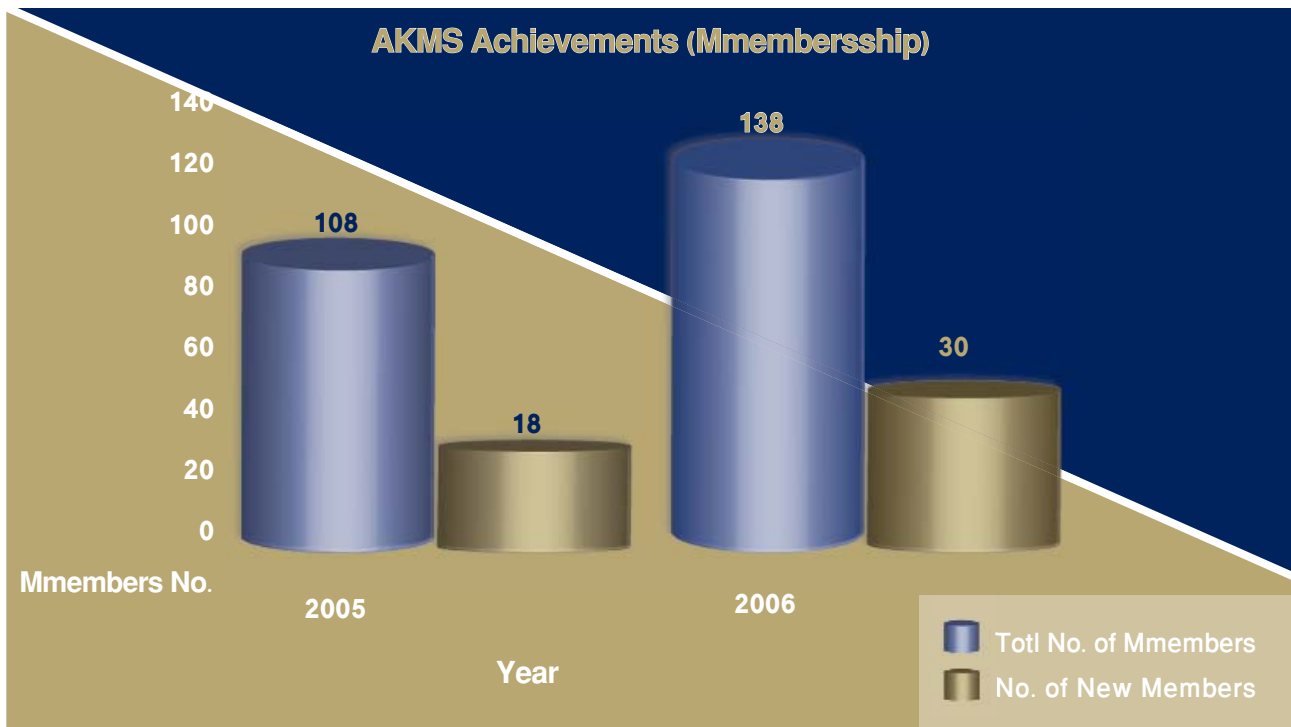
## Master Program

The main frameworks for the master degree in quality management have been established as one of TAGCB programs in cooperation with AKMS. The program is designed to prepare candidates for administrative positions through which they will be able to apply methods of total quality management as well as the recognized management skills in order to help them achieve quality and profit. The program is also designed to prepare candidates to sit for ACQM examinations. In addition, AKMS has participated in marketing TAGCB master programs, especially the Master Degree in Quality Management during the open day held at the College.

AKMS members amounted in December 31, 2006 to (138) regular members after the cancellation of those who have not paid their subscription fees for more than two years. The number of new members amounted to (30) in 2006 compared to (18) members in 2005.

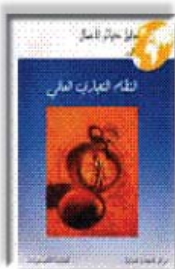
## Publications
